 This form of proxy must be signed by you or your attorney duly authorised in writing. In the case of a corporation, the same must be either under its common seal or under the hand of an officer, attorney or other person duly authorised to sign the same. If the form of proxy is signed by an attorney of the shareholder, the power of attorney authorising that attorney to sign or other document(s) of authorisation must be notarized.

 In case of joint holders of any share, any one of such joint holders may vote at the AGM, either personally or by proxy, in respect of such shares as if he is solely entitled thereto. However, if more than one of such joint holders may vote at the AGM, either personally or by proxy, the vote of the joint holder whose name stands first in the register of members and who tenders a vote, whether persona

Completion and return of a form of proxy will not preclude a shareholder from attending and voting
- in person at the AGM if he so wishes.
